This is led by Sue Daniel, who is based at our Chalkhill medical centre in Haywards Heath.



We realise that it is crucial for us to develop our students confidence and employability skills to prepare them to engage in the opportunities available to them, to take their next steps and be work ready. To do this we will provide confidence building workshops and the whole school will be focusing on developing the skills within the Skills Builder Programme. 


